From Saratoga: Take Rt. 29 East to Wall St. (Just before Grangerville) Turn left onto Wall Street & follow to the end. Turn left onto Rt. 32. Farm is 1/4 mile on the right.

From Schuylerville: Take Route 32 North for 4 miles, farm is on the right.

From Greenwich: Take Rt. 29 West to Schuylerville, turn right onto Route 32 North, 4 miles to the farm.

From Glens Falls: Take Rt. 32 South, farm is 4 miles south of Gansevoort.
